Cutting with the Accuquilt Tumbler dies.

During the May TRPQG meeting you have an opportunity to use an Accuquilt cutter to cut out tumbler blocks. If you own a GO Cutter please bring it to the meeting. If you have any of the tumbler blocks please bring them as well.

Below is a chart of the three dies that will be available to use with quilt sizes and the approximate number of blocks needed to create a quilt.

You are only limited by your imagination in designing a tumbler quilt. Use as few as two different fabrics to as many as the number needed to make the quilt the size you want it. Think tumbler blocks are boring, piece some scraps together and cut that into a tumbler block. Don't want to create a quilt but want to try the tumbler block use some to make a mug rug, placemat or table topper.

Die information

 $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Tumbler finishes 3" - a $11\frac{1}{2}$ " wide strip yields 24 per strip - 72 per yard

4 ½" Tumbler finishes 4" - a 5" wide strip yields 8 per strip - 56 per yard (charm sq. compatible)

6 ½" Tumbler finishes 6" - a 7 ½" wide strip yields 7 per strip - 28 per yard

Quilt size information

38" x 40" scrappy quilt with 2 1/2" border strips uses 180 - 3 1/2" tumblers

38" x 52" scrappy quilt with no border strips uses $169 - 4\frac{1}{2}$ " tumblers

48" x 78" scrappy quilt with no border strips uses $143 - 6\frac{1}{2}$ " tumblers

38" x 48" scrappy quilt with no border strips uses. $84 - 6\frac{1}{2}$ " tumblers

Ironed fabrics work best. I personally prefer starched fabric.




